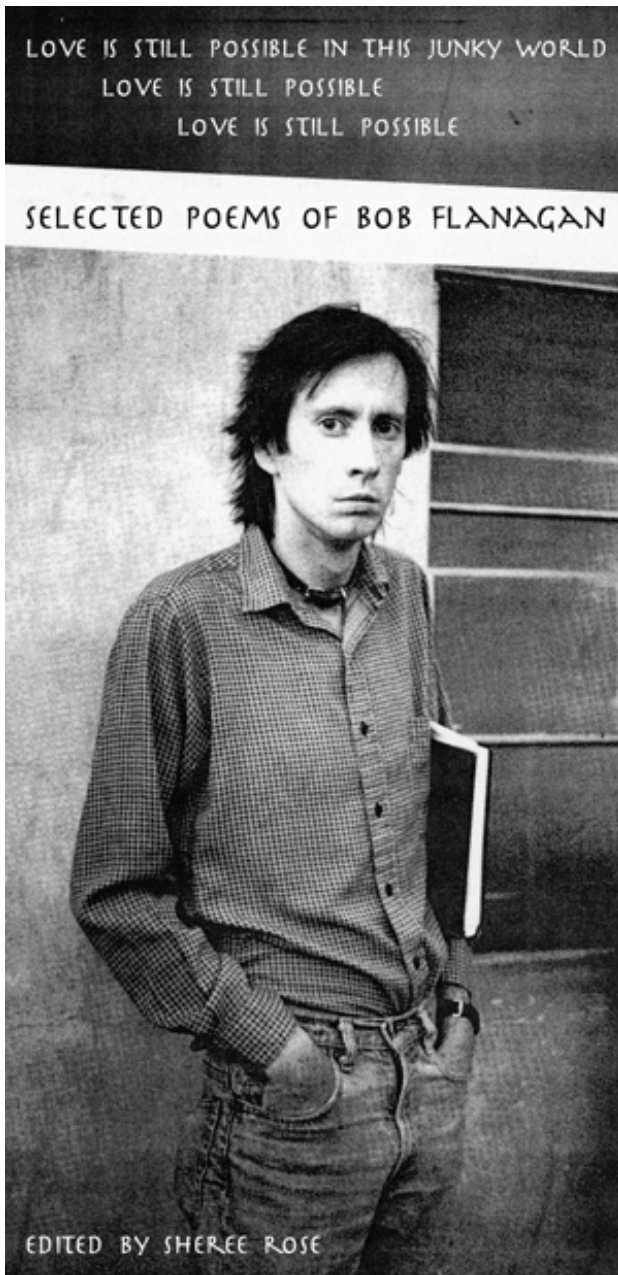

During the Los Angeles poetry movement in the 1980's Dennis Cooper was the director of the poetry workshop called Beyond Baroque Literary in Venice, California. There Bob Flanagan and Sheree Rose connected through their interest and love of poetry. Though best known for their sadomasochistic relationship they were also known as collaborators of art, writing, photography and performance.
